Example: *Battle of Stalingrad*: A battle fought between the German and Soviet armies in 1943 (THIS IS HOW TO IDENTIFY). It was a major turning point in the war as the Soviets defeated the Germans and stopped their move into the Soviet Union (THIS IS HOW TO STATE THE SIGNIFICANCE).
